Representatives from the Lebanon City Schools, Little Miami School, Warren County Young Professionals and Jake Jones, Building Services Director, were present for the official Kick-off o the 4 th Annual Holiday Food Drive Challenge.
Mrs. South stated the huge success this food drive has had in the past and stated that the number of barrels being placed throughout the community for this year's drive has increased significantly She then discussed the "Basketball for Food" games and how the Lebanon City Schools food drive model has been picked up by the State of Ohio High School Athletics Association and is being utilized by approximately 500 high schools through out the State of Ohio.
