2023 Action Plan of the 2019-2023

Consolidated Plan for Warren County, Ohio

In 2019, the Warren County Board of Commissioners adopted a Five-Year Consolidated Plan for HUD Entitlement Programs administered by Warren County, including the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). The Plan describes housing and community development needs and objectives for the five-year period of May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2024. The Annual Action Plan which describes projects to be implemented pending available funding during FY2023 is summarized below:

\$ 642,388 for Construction Projects:

- City of Lebanon – Cherry Street Reconstruction Project
- City of Franklin – Mackinaw Subdivision Project
- Union Township – Highland Park – Phase 2
- Village of Butlerville – Hill & Walnut Street Project
- City of South Lebanon – Hobart Street Project

\$110,000 for Public Service Projects:

- Warren County Safe on Main
- Family Promise of Warren County

\$35,000 for Administration

Warren County will hold a public hearing on its 2023 Action Plan on Wednesday, April 5, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. in the County Commissioners' Meeting Room, 406 Justice Drive, Lebanon, Ohio. Accommodations for disabled or non-English speaking residents will be made available upon advance request. Warren County will make the 2023 Action Plan immediately available for a 30-day public comment period. Written comments must be received by April 19, 2023, to be considered.
